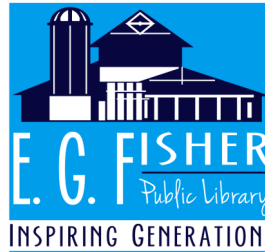

## Children's Programs
