

# SUMMER READING 2019 LISTENER

Listeners are children who do not read independently. Listeners track their reading by the number of books read to them.

---

Summer fun is for all ages at E.G. Fisher Public Library! Reading during the summer helps prevent learning loss and gives kids an opportunity to explore interests.

## **STEP 1: REGISTER YOUR CHILD AT [WWW.FISHERLIBRARY.ORG](http://WWW.FISHERLIBRARY.ORG) OR ON E.G. FISHER PUBLIC LIBRARY'S FACEBOOK**

- You can print your child's reading logs at home or pick up a copy at the library.
- If you are uncomfortable registering online, paper registration is available at the library.

## **STEP 2: LOG YOUR CHILD'S READING**

- Write your child's FIRST & LAST NAME on his or her reading log(s).
- Begin logging your child's reading on May 30th . Reading before May 30th should not be counted.
- Once your child completes one reading log you can pick up a new reading log at E.G. Fisher Public Library or print additional reading logs at [www.fisherlibrary.org](http://www.fisherlibrary.org) on the Summer Reading Program page.

## **STEP 3: SPIN THE PRIZE WHEEL**


- Once your child reaches a benchmark he or she can come to the library anytime to spin the prize wheel. For Listeners the first benchmark is 10 books.
- You must bring all of your child's reading logs to the library to spin the prize wheel.
- Your child will receive the prize his or her spin lands on. Children may not spin again, however he or she is welcome to trade prizes with other children.
- Continue to bring your child to the library to spin the prize wheel each time he or she reaches a benchmark! Benchmarks are a total of all of the pages read since the beginning of the program.

## **STEP 4: TURN IN YOUR READING LOGS AND GET YOUR PARTICIPATION CERTIFICATE!**

- Turn in your reading logs by MONDAY JULY 22ND in order to enter for the grand prize and to receive a participation certificate. This is the last day to spin the wheel.
- All children that read at least 50 pages and turn in their reading logs will receive a certificate with prizes/coupons attached. These certificates will be available to pick up at the final program, July 25th at 4:00 pm. If you can't make it to the final program, you can pick up the certificates at the library until August 9th.

Benchmarks are the total number of pages read since the beginning of the summer reading program.

## LISTENERS: COUNTING BY BOOKS

- 10th book = 1st spin
- 20th book = 2nd spin
- 30th book= 3rd spin
- 40th book= 4th spin
- 50th book= 5th spin
- 75th book= 6th spin
- 100th book= 7th spin
- 125th book= 8th spin
- 150th book= 9th spin
- 180th book= 10th spin
- 220th book= 11th spin
- 260th book= 12th spin
- +40 additional books = additional spin
